1. The ministry will outgrow you.

Pastors tend to hold on to too much for too long.

Acts 6:1-7

Don't become the leadership lid. Empower future leaders.

Exodus 18:18 --> Avoid ministry burnout!

2. You'll stay too focused on the execution rather than the outcomes.

Parable of the Talents

Great leaders will leave your ministry if you focus on the execution instead of the outcomes.

Questions potential leaders are asking:

- Am I needed?
- Will I have input?
- Will they keep me in the loop?
- Do they care about me or are they using me?
- Will they let me lead?
- Do I get to do something significant?

3. You'll avoid giving volunteers the opportunity to serve and lead.

Ephesians 4:12-13

Our role as leaders is to "equip God's people to do his work."

- Lead other people
- Lead other leaders
- Lead by vision
